VETERANS COMMUNITY PROJECT TO BREAK GROUND ON VETERANS COMMUNITY CENTER

Community Center will Provide Needed Support to Veterans Working to Get Back on their Feet

- WHO:** [Veterans Community Project](#), a non-profit organization founded in Kansas City by Veterans for Veterans, will break ground on a new Community Center to provide services to the those living in transitional tiny houses for homeless Veterans in VCP Village.
- WHAT:** The Community Center, a 4,600 square foot facility, will provide case management services, education, health and wellness programming, social, and community-led activities to the Veterans who live in the village. This continuum of services leads to improved health and stability.
- The Community Center will offer a full continuum of care that enhances the housing support provided by VCP Village. This broad approach addresses the root causes of homelessness by providing longer-term intensive health, wellness, self-sufficiency and community engagement services.
- The third and final phase of construction is underway on the remaining 23 tiny houses. The construction of this facility would not be possible without the generous support of the community. For donors interested, room sponsorships are still available.
